Introduction Universal wall speaker

The WXMK2 loudspeaker series is designed to be a universal performance speaker, ensuring true—to—nature, high fidelity reproduction of music and speech in every environement, ranging from modern residential applications to the most demanding designer applications in environements such as retail stores, pubs, restaurants and even clubs.

It features a stunningly designed and elegant looking ABS housing which is fitted with high quality components. The speaker is available in three sizes, 3", 5 1/4" and 8". All speakers are available in black and white, making them blend into every environement, going from standard indoor home to special indoor design interiors. The included mounting bracket allows horizontal and vertical mounting as well as focusing of the speaker, and an integrated advanced protection network protects the tweeter against overload.



Installing the WXMK2

Step 1: Mount the loudspeaker

The loudspeaker can be mounted both horizontally and vertically by means of the supplied mounting bracket. For mounting the loudspeaker on the desired mounting location, the mounting bracket should be removed from the loudspeaker. This can be done by loosening the thumbscrews on either side of the loudspeaker. After this is done, the mounting holes should be indicated.

For a stable mounting of the loudspeaker it should always be fastened by two screws. The position of the mounting holes depends on the mounting orientation, horizontally or vertically. After this, the bracket can be mounted on the desired location. Always use the proper fasteners depending of the mounting surface. Once the bracket is mounted on the desired location, the loudspeaker can be fixed to the bracket.

Step 2: Power settings

On the rear side of the WXMK2 series loudspeakers, a recessed adjuster screw is provided. Using this adjuster screw the power / impedance of the loudspeaker can be set in 3 adjustable steps of impedance for 100V and 1 step for standard low impedance applications.





When the loudspeaker is connected to 70.7V facilities, the power indicated in the table above will be reduced to half the power, and when connected to 50V facilities, the power will be reduced to a quarter.

Step 3: Make the connections

A terminal block connector with linkthrough possibility is provided on the back of the loudspeaker. The connection can be made by loosening the connection screws of the terminals, inserting the wires according to the polarity as shown below. After tighten—ing the screws, the connector can be insterted into its counterpart on the back of the speaker.

Mind the polarity markings when wiring the loudspeaker cables.



Step 4: Enjoy the music

After the WX loudspeakers have been installed correctly, you deserve to have a short break, relax and enjoy the sound of the speakers!
